

Visiting 'Live ACT'

IAACT's blog, 'Live ACT,' is located at iaact.com/blog. Links to the blog are also available from iaact.com.

Reading and Commenting

Anyone can read a blog, but only registered users may comment. To register, visit google.com/accounts. On the right side, click "Create an account now." Complete the form to create your Google account.

Note: Google uses an e-mail address as your username. If you already have an e-mail address, feel free to use that one. If you do not have an e-mail address or if you would like a new e-mail address, visit gmail.com to create a Gmail address.

Now that you have a Google account, you can comment on IAACT's blog. Visit the blog at iaact.com/blog, and when you find a post where you want to leave a comment, click "# comments" (where # represents the comments others have already left) below each post.

In the right sidebar, leave your comment in the box provided, complete the "Word Verification," and login with your Google account username and password. Then click "Publish your comment." Your comment should appear under the post within a day or so. (We moderate the comments to prevent spam.)

Posting

IAACT faculty members and other PCT gurus have been invited to post on 'Live ACT.' Posting is allowed by invitation only.

To post on 'Live ACT,' visit blogger.com, and login at the top of the page with your Google account. The next page is the Blogger Dashboard, where you should see 'Live ACT' listed as a blog. Click "New post." Remember to give your post a title, and apply the appropriate labels (click "Show all" to see all the options). Using the labels will help readers navigate the blog by topic. When you are finished, click "Publish post."
